The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received your complete application on June 19, 2006 to breach the Woolen Mills dam on the Rivanna River in Charlottesville, Virginia.

Because the water quality impacts should be minimal and/or temporary in nature, based on the JPA noted above, and because this project is expected to receive Nationwide Permits (NWP) 27 & 33 from the USACE for which DEQ has provided unconditional (NWP 33) and conditional (NWP 27) § 401 Certification, a Virginia Water Protection (VWP) permit will not be required for this project. This letter constitutes the § 401 Certification of your § 404 permit for this project.
