Land Use:

Mostly open space and wooded areas, with some farms and residential.

Wildlife Sightings and Plant Life:

Turtles, 3 Green Heron, 1 Great Blue Heron, 5 Long Nose Gar, Small Fish, Dragonflies, Spiders, Damselflies, Geese, 1 Kingfisher, 1 Pileated Woodpecker, Small Birds, Butterflies, Vultures, Crow, Frog, Deer. Most of the banks were well vegetated, with some erosion on the banks.

People Interactions:

We saw a few people fishing near Camp Friendship, and one other person at Crofton, but otherwise it was quiet today on the Rivanna.

Litter and Pollution:

Not much trash found today, just a couple of bottles and a bucket. We saw about 5 tires in and around the River during the paddle as well. Some of the banks at River Left near Crofton are pretty severely eroded.

Overall Summary:

There was just enough water in the Rivanna River to make the paddle possible without too much trouble with the boats scraping the bottom. Lots of wildlife out again today. We also replaced some of the RCA maps and brochures today in the Crofton and Palmyra information kiosks.
